The respected sculptor Lovemore Bonjisi (*1985) comes from a renowned Zimbabwean stone sculptor dynasty with long history and tradition. Owing to his exceptional skills, he has been nicknamed the Michelangelo of Africa. Bonjisi has dedicated himself to art since a young age. He lives and creates in Harare, Zimbabwe. His sculptures are featured in various private collections all over the world, and his art has been showed in numerous galleries e.g. in Germany, the Netherlands, Australia, USA, or Korea. Bonjisi's art is very dynamic and combines elements of the Zimbabwean Shona Sculpture Movement with ingredients of contemporary world art.

In 2007 Bonjisi visited the Czech Republic. During his stay he presented his artistic production live in the Prague Botanic Garden. He donated this beautiful sculpture to Centrum Narovinu on this occasion.

The sculpture originates in Bonjisi's Harare atelier. It is carved from one piece of springstone and is in good condition.
